Bethel Selectboard

Bethel Town Manager Dell Cloud reported that the dump truck has been delivered to the transfer station and is working well.

Discussion ensued concerning the management structure of the Transfer Station. Mr. Cloud reported that the transfer station is structured as a Union Municipal District, later discussion leaned towards the management structure being only an Inter-municipal agreement or possible just a simple agreement.

Discussion ensued on the ability of the Bethel and Royalton Selectboard's setting up a management structure as they feel fit to handle the day to day affairs of the Transfer Station. However in the case of borrowing money, both towns would have to vote and approve the borrowing of money.

Vermont State Statute (title 24 V.S.A. 4901) refers to inter local contracts

It was agreed to meet in Bethel on September 26, 2012, to further discuss the management of the Transfer Station.

Transfer Station Manager Chet Wood suggested raising the fees for appliances. It costs the facility \$10.00 to get the Freon removed. He suggests an increase to \$15.00 in the fees for appliances. Motion by J. Goldstein, second by P. Gates to increase appliance fees to \$15.00 effective October 1, 2012. Motion passed unopposed.

Financial statements from the previous budget year were reviewed.
