Royalton Hill Ditching

Trucking, contingent upon reference check. Motion passed 4-0**

received by Terry Rogers at \$6.41 per linear foot. **J. Goldstein moved to contract with
Terry Rogers for Johnson Hill Rd. ditching, E. Amsden seconded. Motion passed 4-
