

TIMETABLE AND SEQUENCE

PK-12 OPERATING STUDY COMMITTEE

June 13 Reconsideration Vote in Royalton on Plan A

20 Reconsideration Vote in Rochester on Plan A

If Royalton passes and Rochester is upheld, all three districts are created under the original plan.

If Royalton fails to overturn its previous result or Rochester rejects the proposal, the PK-12 operating district Plan A fails and the others remain in limbo.

If Plan A does not get adopted, Plan B must be moved forward for a vote after the results of the original vote are certified.

August xx Vote in Bethel and Rochester on Plan B

If both pass and the 30-day reconsideration period expires, Plan B is adopted and all approved districts in the side-by-side will go into existence.

This committee ceases to exist under three circumstances: Plan A is successful and the results are certified within 15 days. Or Plan A is unsuccessful and Plan B is successfully adopted and the results certified. Or both plans are defeated and the results are certified.

PK-8 OPERATING STUDY COMMITTEE

29 Reconsideration Vote in Tunbridge

If Tunbridge does not overturn its original vote, the Chelsea/Tunbridge merger remains approved, awaiting the creation of a PK-12 operating district.

If Tunbridge reverses its outcome, Chelsea and Tunbridge are both floating and need to go back to the drawing board.

The PK-6/8 Study Committee ceases to exist when the results are certified within 15 days of the reconsideration vote and when the PK-12 district is created, providing for the creation of this district.

Legal counsel is sought to determine whether under H.513 these communities can proceed with their Unification, as a side-by-side with the non-operating group, without taking another vote of the electorate.

NON-OPERATING STUDY COMMITTEE

Communities voted overwhelmingly to unify.

Awaiting creation of a PK-12 operating district.

The Non-operating study committee ceases to exist when the results are certified for the creation of the PK-12 district, and therefore, the creation of this district.

Legal counsel is sought to determine whether under H.513 these communities can proceed with their Unification, as a side-by-side with the PK-8 Operating group, without taking another vote of the electorate.

OTHER THREE DISTRICTS

Unless they are involved in another comprehensive unification proposal, they may need to seek 2-2-1 or 3-1 status or will need to seek approval as an “alternative structure”. Proposal due 11/24/17.

NEW TIMETABLE

For Act 153/156 Incentives

Successful vote by 11/30/17

State Board—October

Plan voted on by study committee around October 1

For 2-2-1 or 3-1 Proposals

Electorate votes in all towns by 11/30/17 (All boards have to approve, but electorate does not have to vote if already merged.)

State Board—October

Plan voted on by boards around October 1

No incentives for the “one” in a new structure
