Larry Trottier opened the Public Hearing at 7pm.

The Town of Royalton is applying to the State of Vermont for a Community Development Block Grant for the following project as described below:

The existing roadway is to be abandoned and replaced with a finished gravel road measuring 24' by 1000' designed to current V-Trans codes and standards for class 3 roads. The new road segment will be located immediately south of the existing road. As recommended by a professional geomorphologist, a low height rip rap to is to be placed at the base of the embankment of the White River for protection against further erosion. $(400' \times 16'6' = 38400 \text{cf} / 27) = 1422 \text{cy}$. This project includes road construction, signage, ditching and guardrails.

Roger McCrillis spoke about some changes he would recommend to the preliminary plans to repair this road. The Selectboard reviewed an estimated budget and discussed material quantities and costs. The application will be submitted on 08/04/14.
