Babe Ruth League Waiver

THIS ENTRY FORM AND RELEASE IS A DOCUMENT WITH LEGAL CONSEQUENCES AND I HAVE BEEN ADVISED TO READ IT CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING. BY SIGNING IT, I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT I AM RELEASING BABE RUTH LEAGUE, INC. ("Babe Ruth Online") AND ITS RESPECTIVE AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, MEMBERS, SPONSORS, PROMOTERS AND AFFILIATES (COLLECTIVELY "RELEASEES") FROM LIABILITY.

I hereby expressly and affirmatively state that I named herein, wish to participate in the above activity. I assume full and complete responsibility for any injury or accident, which may occur while I am traveling to or from the event, during the event, or while I am on the premises of the event. I understand the risks of my participation in this activity and knowing and appreciating these risks I voluntarily choose to participate, assuming all risks of injury or even death as a result of my participation.

In consideration of the acceptance of my application for entry in the event, I hereby waive, release and discharge any and all claims for damages for death, personal injury or property

damage which I may have, or which may hereafter accrue to me, as a result of my participation in said event. This release is intended to discharge in advance the promoters, the sponsors, Babe Ruth League, Inc. Services, any affiliated organizations, the promoting club(s), team(s), or person(s), the officials, and any involved municipalities or other public entities (and their respective agents and employees) from and against any and all liability arising out of or connected in any way with my participation in said event, even though that liability may arise from the negligence or carelessness of persons or entities mentioned above.

I understand that there is a transaction fee associated with this event and that the entire fee (entry plus transaction) is non-refundable and non-transferable. I have also read and agree to the terms and conditions contained in the Participation Agreement, which explain my rights and responsibilities hereunder, including all Dispute Procedures governing transactions of Payment Services.

I hereby grant full permission to any and all of the above parties to use any photographs, videotapes, motion pictures, website images, recordings or any other record of this event.

1. Authority to Register and/or to Act as Agent. You represent and warrant to Babe Ruth League, Inc. Sport Parent Code of Conduct

We, the South Royalton Baseball and Softball League, have implemented the following Sport Parent Code of Conduct for the important message it holds about the proper role of parents in supporting their child in sports.

Parents should read, understand and sign this form prior to their children participating in our league. Any parent guilty of improper conduct at any game or practice will be asked to leave the sports facility and be suspended from the following game. Repeat violations may cause a multiple game suspension, or the season forfeiture of the privilege of attending all games.

Preamble

The essential elements of character building and ethics in sports are embodied in the concept of sportsmanship and six core principles:

- Trustworthiness,
- Respect,
- Responsibility,
- Fairness,
- Caring, and
- Good Citizenship

The highest potential of sports is achieved when competition reflects these “six pillars of character.”

I therefore agree:

1. I will not force my child to participate in sports.
2. I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.
3. I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
4. I will learn the rules of the game and the policies of the league.
5. I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or other sporting event.
6. I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent such as booing and

taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language or gestures.

7. I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and well being of the athletes.
8. I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
9. I will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.
10. I will teach my child that doing one’s best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance.
11. I will praise my child for competing fairly and trying hard, and make my child feel like a winner every time.
12. I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
13. I will emphasize skill development and practices and how they benefit my child over winning. I will also de-emphasize games and competition in the lower age groups.
14. I will promote the emotional and physical wellbeing of the athletes ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.
15. I will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the game field, and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
16. I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and I will refrain from their use at all sports events.
17. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.
