The meeting was called to order at 7:15 pm.

In the absence of Kimberly from TRORC the RPC Clerk Sarah Danley will be making the chapter edits for this session. This meeting was off schedule to make up for a missed meeting on 8-16-2019 which did not have a quorum.

#### Driveway Permit

The first item of business was to review of driveway permit #19-03. The RPC moved to approve the permit with no conditions. It was noted by Bushrod Powers that the elevation of the proposed parking lot was lower than street level but after discussion it did not seem relevant to the RPC's concerns, approval was unanimous.

#### Town Plan

Work on the Ag and Forestry sections of the town plan, discussion on leaving the historic section of the plan unchanged. Reference to AMP (Accepted Management Practices), and BMP (Best Management Practices) in the Ag and Forestry sections should be defined in the Glossary.

Add to Goals- "The town forest should be conserved land." This decision is intended to preserve the decision for future boards and commissions which may not hold the same ideals, entering the land in a conservation program should be a permanent decision.

Forest Blocks added as the last section in the chapter with goals in the beginning of the chapter. Forest block maps should be better images than depicted in the working documents, suggested higher resolution color fold outs.
