Pursuant to 24 V.S.A. § 1973, this Ordinance adoption may be disapproved by a vote of the majority of the qualified voters of the Town voting on the question at an annual or special meeting duly warned for the purpose pursuant to the petition signed and submitted by not less than five percent of the qualified voters of the Town of Royalton and presented to the Selectboard or the Town Clerk within forty-four (44) days following the date that the amendments were adopted. Unless a petition is filed this Ordinance shall become effective September 12, 2020.
