

Minutes of the Meeting of the Royalton Board of Tax Abatement

The Royalton Board of Tax Abatement met at the town offices meeting room on Tuesday, December 11<sup>th</sup>, at 6:30 p.m. The meeting was called to order by Chair Bushrod Powers at 6:35 p.m.

Upon written request of appellant Tim Miller, Parcel S—240 owned by The United Church of South Royalton, a request was made to abate \$2,496.00, approximately 80% of the current property tax bill because the church operates a non-profit community food-shelf alongside a rental trailer on the same lot. Questions and discussion ensued. Chair Powers thanked everyone for coming and the Board of Tax Abatement entered deliberative session.

Upon exiting deliberative session Walter Hastings motioned to abate the \$2,496.00, Brad Morrill-Cornelius seconded. Chair Powers called for vote: All in favor: none. All opposed: ten, with Bascom recused. Motion to abate did not carry. Decision was based on the board's determination that the abatement request did not fall within the limited scope of the statutory criteria they must follow.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:05 p.m.
