

**\*\*PUBLIC NOTICE\*\***

The Royalton Animal Control Ordinance amended February 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2016 Article 4 Section D declares “It shall be a violation for the owner or keeper of any dog(s) or wolf-hybrid(s), cattle, horses, sheep, goats, swine, or fowl to permit or allow said animal to be on the South Royalton Village Green, the Royalton Common and the Carpenter Recreational Field. Such conduct is declared to be a public nuisance.”

Article 9 Section 2 sets the fine for violation of this portion of the ordinance at \$50.00 for a first offense, \$100.00 for a second offense and \$250.00 for a third or subsequent offense.

The Royalton Selectboard respectfully requests that all who are residents of or are visiting the Town of Royalton obey the Animal Control Ordinance. Beginning on July 1, 2021 fines shall be issued for any violation of above ordinance.
